- Ensuring a process is in place to annually evaluate the Board and its Committees' performance in relation to its responsibilities, goals and objectives
- Conducting a review of the By-Laws of the Corporation as required
- Conducting a review of one-third of the governance policies annually
- Conducting a review of the governance structure of the Hospital annually
- Ensuring Board continuity and capability through a structured Board member recruitment process
- Ensuring an effective Board orientation program and the continuing education of the members of the Board
- Ensuring that there is a process in place for the regular review of organizational policies and procedures;
- Preparing for the Annual General Meeting including development of an annual report if required;
- Ensuring there is an effective risk management policy and program for the organization
- Performing other duties as directed by the Board of Directors

- Annual review of Terms of Reference of all committees and makes recommendations to the Board.
- Any decision to be made should be reviewed in terms of its community impact and whether a community engagement plan for this action is required.
