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### Policy

A Code Blue is a planned response to a person that is experiencing a cardiac or respiratory arrest, pre-arrest or whose condition has deteriorated beyond the knowledge, skill or scope of the persons in the immediate area. The goal of Code Blue is to bring the Emergency Response Team to the location of the person in need of emergency assistance.

**The organization does not differentiate between an adult and neonate/pediatric for emergency response to cardiac or respiratory arrest as no pediatric specialist on staff.**

### Procedure

#### Deep River and District Hospital and Four Seasons Lodge

If additional emergency assistance is required:

- Initiate a Code Blue
- Page “ Code Blue and Location x 3” by dialing 7999-2
- The closest crash cart shall be brought to the location
  - Inside Resuscitation Room (Emergency Department)
  - Medical Hallway
- The Emergency Department (ED) RN will bring the glidescope to the location
- The Code Blue stretcher (located in Diagnostic Imaging) shall be used to transport the person to the Emergency Department (ED) for further interventions

#### North Renfrew Family Health Team

If additional emergency assistance is required:

- Initiate a Code Blue
- Page “ Code Blue and Location x 3” by dialing 7999-2
- The closest automated external defibrillator will be brought to the location; do not attempt to transfer the person to the ED
- Call 9-1-1 to dispatch Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and follow directions from dispatch while awaiting arrival of the ambulance.

Outside (parking lot, etc.)

Do not attempt to transfer person. Call EMS and follow directions from dispatch while awaiting arrival of the ambulance.
