

What Are the Diabetes Education Teams?

The teams consist of certified diabetes educators which include registered dietitians and registered nurses in hospital clinic sites and outreach sites.

They work in collaboration with physicians, pharmacists, other health care professionals and family members to deliver client-centered self managed care.

They provide screening assessments to determine an individual's risk for developing diabetes.

They provide both individual and group education and counselling services for clients diagnosed with diabetes or prediabetes.

For complex care they provide telehealth sessions with specialists.

Physician referral is not required.

Working together to deliver client-centered self managed care.
