MONTHLY PROGRESS SNAPSHOT

JULY 17, 2026

Construction of the new Four Seasons Lodge continues to move forward, with overall project completion now reaching approximately 67%. Work continues throughout the building as crews advance interior drywall, mechanical and electrical systems, exterior finishing elements, and concrete work around the home.

Planning for the future home continues alongside construction, with residents helping shape furniture selections, move management planning, and other important decisions that will influence life in the new home. Planning is also underway to procure the furniture and equipment that will furnish the home.

The DRDH Foundation is inviting the community to participate in its first-ever Adventure Poker Run during Deep River Summerfest on August 1. Proceeds from the event will support the Get On Board: Connecting Community campaign, helping fund accessible transportation for future Four Seasons Lodge residents.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

As of July 2026, construction of the new Four Seasons Lodge continues to make steady progress, with overall project completion now reaching approximately 67%. Work continues throughout the building as crews advance both interior and exterior construction. Interior work remains focused on drywall installation and mechanical and electrical systems, while exterior progress continues on the building envelope and other finishing elements.



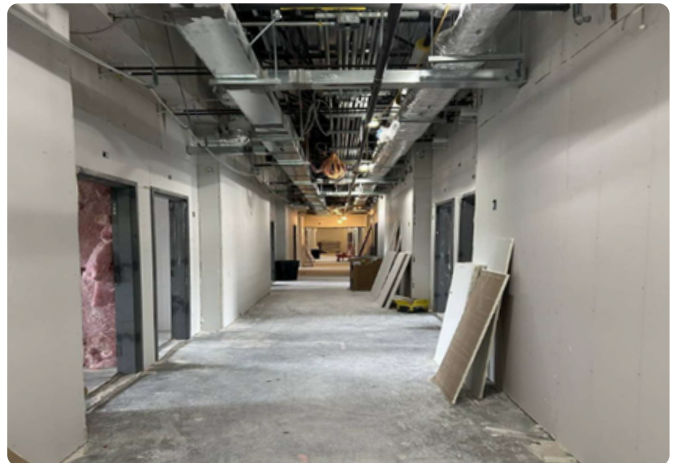

SHAPING THE HOME

PLANNING RESIDENT SPACES

Planning for the new 96-bed Four Seasons Lodge extends far beyond construction. DRDH recognizes the importance of involving residents in decisions that affect their daily lives, and resident input continues to play an important role in shaping the future home.

Over the past several months, residents have helped evaluate furniture and bed models, providing valuable feedback on comfort, accessibility, and functionality. The Residents Council is also reviewing key planning documents, including the Move Management Plan and the orientation approach for new team members, helping ensure the resident perspective is reflected throughout the transition to the new home.

Planning is also well underway to procure the furniture and equipment that will furnish the new home. A recent planning session brought together key stakeholders to refine the procurement schedule, with furniture and equipment orders expected to be placed by the end of 2026. Regular planning meetings will continue throughout the process to help ensure timelines remain on track and procurement decisions reflect the needs of residents and staff.

By involving residents in decisions both large and small, DRDH is creating a home that reflects the needs, preferences, and everyday experiences of the people who will live there.
