MONTHLY PROGRESS SNAPSHOT

AUGUST 18, 2026

Construction of the new Four Seasons Lodge continues to progress, with overall project completion now reaching approximately 69%. Exterior cladding and fibre cement panels are taking shape, while drywall installation continues throughout the interior. Work is also beginning in the courtyard, with concrete curbs and asphalt planned for this month.

Planning for resident spaces is also moving forward, with teams evaluating finishes, colours, and design features that will help create a welcoming and supportive environment. Community input opportunities will be introduced in the coming months to help shape elements of the new home.

The DRDH Foundation's 24th Annual Golf Tournament takes place Thursday, August 27, in support of accessible transportation for the new Four Seasons Lodge. Funds raised will help ensure future residents can access healthcare services, participate in community activities, and remain connected.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

As of August 2026, construction of the new Four Seasons Lodge continues to move forward, with overall project completion now reaching approximately 69%. Exterior work continues with architectural concrete cladding and fibre cement panels being installed, giving the building an increasingly finished appearance. Inside, drywall installation and finishing continue to advance, while painting has been completed in the main utility room. Work is also beginning in the courtyard, with concrete curbs and asphalt planned as part of the next phase of outdoor work.

PLANNING RESIDENT SPACES

Planning for the new Four Seasons Lodge continues as we prepare for completion of construction and, ultimately, moving residents and team members into the new home in 2027.

Occupancy planning is underway, including preparing the plans that will guide the move into the new building. There are many details to consider to ensure the transition is well coordinated and as smooth as possible for residents, families, and team members.

We are also getting closer to some of the exciting finishing decisions that will help make the new building feel like home. In the coming weeks, teams will begin selecting flooring, wall colours, and other interior finishes. These choices will balance comfort and accessibility with durability and ease of maintenance, while creating warm and welcoming spaces for residents.

Initial discussions are also underway about how the dedicated memory care neighbourhood will operate and how the space can best support residents living with dementia. This planning goes hand-in-hand with decisions about furniture and furnishings, helping ensure the environment supports comfort, safety, independence, and meaningful daily living.

Thank you to everyone who has already helped with the initial selection of furniture for resident lounges and living areas. Your experience and input are helping us choose furniture that will be comfortable and functional, while creating spaces where residents can relax, visit, and feel at home.

Each of these decisions brings us another step closer to turning the new Four Seasons Lodge from a building under construction into a home for our residents.
