MONTHLY PROGRESS SNAPSHOT

SEPTEMBER 15, 2026

Construction of the new Four Seasons Lodge continues to progress, with overall project completion now reaching approximately 71%. Exterior cladding installation is nearing completion, while drywall, mudding, taping, and painting continue on the second floor.

Planning for the new home is reaching important milestones, including the submission of the Occupancy Plan to the Ministry of Long-Term Care. This brings together key areas of readiness and helps move the project from construction toward opening. Residents are also continuing to provide input on interior finishes and design choices that will help make the new Lodge feel welcoming and familiar.

The DRDH Foundation's Get On Board: Connecting Community campaign is nearing its \$750,000 goal. The recent Foundation Golf Tournament provided another boost toward accessible transportation, helping future residents access healthcare, participate in activities, and remain connected with their community.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

As of September 2026, construction of the new Four Seasons Lodge continues to progress, with overall project completion now reaching approximately 71%. Exterior cladding and fibre cement panel installation is nearing completion, as well as interior drywall installation on the second floor. Mudding, taping, and painting are also progressing on the second floor. Work is also beginning to move into the courtyard and other outdoor areas, with concrete curbs, asphalt, and a concrete pad for the gas supply planned as part of the next phase of site work.



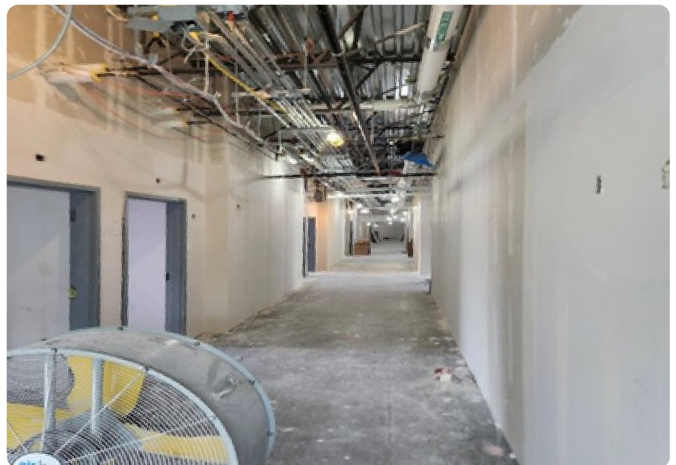

SHAPING THE HOME

PLANNING RESIDENT SPACES

Planning for the new Four Seasons Lodge continues as we prepare for completion of construction and, ultimately, welcoming residents and team members into the new home in 2027.

A major milestone was reached this month with the submission of our Occupancy Plan to the Ministry of Long-Term Care. The Occupancy Plan brings together the many details needed to prepare the new home for residents, including operational readiness, staffing, resident care, safety, and the transition from our existing space into the new building.

Submitting the plan is an important step in moving the project from construction toward opening. Before residents can move into the new home, the project must meet provincial requirements and receive the necessary approvals for occupancy. The work underway now will help ensure that when the building is ready, DRDH is ready too. While there is still significant work ahead, reaching this milestone means we are getting closer to the day we can welcome residents into their new home.

Residents are also continuing to help shape the details of that home. The Four Seasons Lodge Residents' Council recently reviewed sample boards featuring flooring, paint colours, fabrics, tile, and other interior finishes. Their feedback is helping inform choices that balance comfort, accessibility, durability, and ease of maintenance while creating spaces that feel welcoming and familiar.

As planning continues, there will be more opportunities for residents, families, team members, and community members to contribute their ideas. Watch for upcoming opportunities to help shape the details, design, and identity of the new Four Seasons Lodge.
